2010 NORTHERN TABLELANDS WESTERN HORSE CHALLENGE SERIES

WHAT IS IT?

The Challenge Series is a series of events being staged over 5 shows to be held on the Northern Tablelands area, at Uralla, Armidale, Inverell and Glen Innes. A points score will be held over the series, with Trophy Buckles to be presented to the winner of each of the three main categories, being Youth, Amateur and All Aged (Open).

The aim of the Challenge Series is two-fold, being to both encourage competitors to support the Agricultural Shows on the Northern Tablelands (*to ensure their continued support of our events*) and provide those interested in Western horses with a place to exhibit their horses.

HOW IT WORKS

1. The Challenge Series shall have three main divisions, being Youth, Amateur and All Aged/Open (Horse).
2. Horses and riders must nominate for the series and pay the entry fee of \$10 for each division in which they nominate. Challenge Series nomination fees are separate to the entry fees payable for the individual events held at each show.
3. Prizemoney shall only be that which is offered by the individual Show Society for the individual event and shall only be paid as per their own conditions and regulations.
4. For Youth and Amateur divisions in the Challenge Series it shall be "one horse, one rider" (*horse substitutions may be allowed only in cases where the original nominated horse is injured or dies*).
5. Horses may be nominated in more than one division, i.e. with different riders in Youth and Amateur divisions, or in the All Aged/Open (Horse) division plus the Amateur or Youth division etc.
6. Over the course of the Challenge Series entrants will compete in all the usual events found at western horse shows. At each of the listed shows there shall be two events on the program nominated as point earning events for the Challenge Series for each division. For example: at one show the Youth Challenge entrants may have the Showmanship and Trail classes nominated as point earning Challenge Series events, at the next show it may be Hunter Under Saddle and Western Horsemanship that are the nominated events, and at the next show it may be Western Pleasure and Reining etc.
The events listed as point earning Challenge events for each division at each show are all listed in this program.
7. To be eligible for any Challenge Series awards participants must compete at a minimum of three of the five Shows listed.
8. All events shall be run under AQHA or HSAA rules, as per the regulations for the hosting show.
9. Points shall be awarded based on the table shown below, with the highest point-scorer in each division being named the winner. In the event of a tie there shall be a count-back, with the horse/rider with the highest number of 1st placings in Challenge Series events for that division being named the winner, then going to highest number of 2nd placings or 3rd placings, should that be required in order to break the tie.
10. At the discretion of the organisers and subject to sponsorship being forthcoming other awards may be presented, for example High Point Quarter Horse, High Point Paint Horse etc.
11. All awards to be made for the Challenge Series shall be presented at an awards function at the completion of the series (venue and date to be advised).

General Conditions for all shows

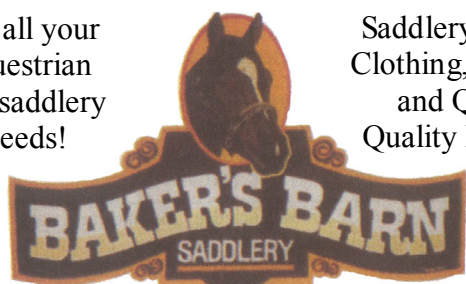
- All events run under AQHA/HSAA rules
- All horses shown in Halter classes must be registered with their respective societies, papers may be requested.
- Junior Horses are 5 yrs & under and may be ridden in either a snaffle, a hackamore or bitted.
- Senior Horses are 6 yrs & over and must be bitted and ridden one handed.
- Youth competitors are 18 yrs and under.
- Amateurs/Youths must be registered Amateurs / Youths with their respective societies.
- Beginner / Improvers are competitors that are new to the discipline of Western Pleasure or Hunter. They can be of any age or level in

general riding. All horses in Beginner / Improver classes may be ridden with a snaffle bit two handed, but if the horse is bitted (shank bit) they must be ridden one handed. If your horse is bitted and you touch the reins with your free hand you will be disqualified. Any tack can be used as long as it's in good repair and meets safety standards. Riders must wear a long sleeve button up collar shirt, jeans, heeled riding boots and a western hat (hard hats may also be used if preferred).

- To allow competitors time to change attire there shall be a break of 15 minutes between the completion of Halter and the start of Performance events. Likewise there shall be a break of 15 minutes between the completion of the English events and the start of the Western events.

Stabling and Camping is available at Armidale Showground for the February 6th & 7th weekend.
Stabling \$6 per stable per night. Camping \$11 per vehicle.
