

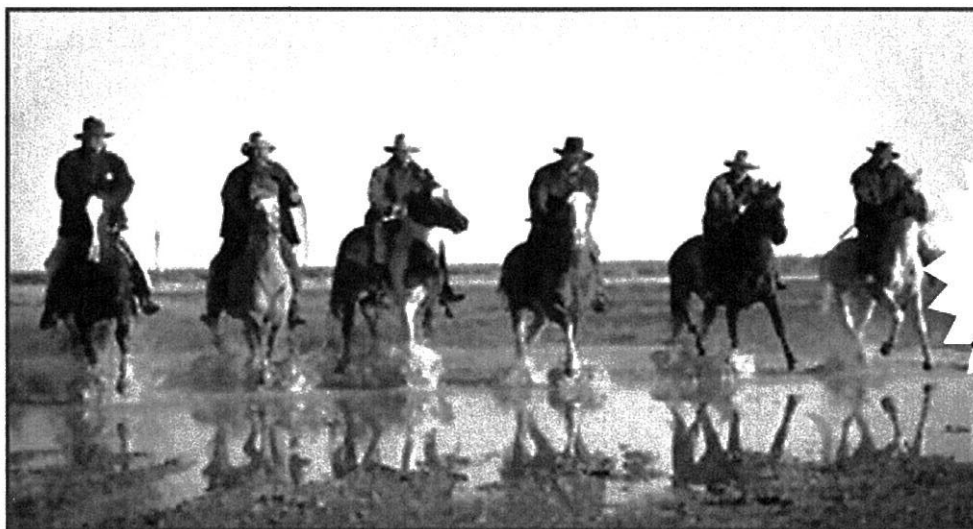

Saturday June 12th, 2010 at the Armidale Exhibition Centre. 8.00 am start.

The Armidale Stockman's Challenge is an event being staged by the Armidale & New England Show Society, the Armidale Campdraft Club and the Northern Tablelands Western Horse Club to assist with fundraising for the construction of a new Canteen and Office facility at the Armidale Exhibition Centre!

The event will be comprised of three separate stages, being:

TWO HANDED CUTTING * **WORKING COWHORSE** * **INDOOR CAMPDRAFT**
(NCHA Rules) (AQHA Rules) (ACA Rules)

Prizemoney: \$1000
(paid to 4th placing)

Entries close:

Conditions:

1. Entries shall be limited to the first fifty (50) nominations received in total.
2. Competitors shall be limited to no more than two nominations.
3. Points will be allocated to the placegetters in each stage of the Stockman's Challenge, with the overall winner to be the competitor earning the highest number of points over the three stages.
4. Sashes will be awarded to the overall placegetters in the Stockman's Challenge, in addition to the placegetters for each leg of the Stockman's Challenge. Trophies will be awarded to the overall winner plus the winners of each of the legs of the Stockman's Challenge.
5. Prizemoney will be paid out on the overall placings for the Stockman's Challenge, not on the individual stages of the event.
6. Additional awards will be presented to:
 - > Highest Point Scoring Lady competitor (\$100 + trophy)
 - > Highest Point Scoring Youth competitor (\$100 + trophy)
 - > Highest Point Scoring Registered Quarter Horse (Trophy donated by Silver Spur Quarter Horse Stud — Inverell)
 - > Highest Point Scoring Registered Paint / Paint-Bred Horse (Trophy donated by Oak Ridge Performance Horses)
 - > Highest Point Scoring Registered Australian Stock Horse (Trophy donated by Northern Branch of the Australian Stock Horse Society)
7. All horses to be aged three years or over. Senior horses (aged 6 years and over) MAY be shown two-handed and in a snaffle bit for the Working Cowhorse stage of the event.

AQHA WORKING COWHORSE PATTERN No 1

Class Procedure:

The event comprises two portions, being reined work (pattern), followed by cow work. Both portions of this event are mandatory.

Upon entering the arena the competitor will proceed to the starting point shown in the pattern, acknowledge the judge and commence reined work.

At the completion of the reined work the competitor is to perform cow work, indicating to stewards when he/she is ready for the cow to be released into the arena.

For an ideal cow work, each contestant, upon receiving a cow in the arena, shall hold the cow on the prescribed end of the arena for sufficient time to demonstrate the ability of the horse to contain the cow on that end. After a reasonable amount of time, the contestant shall take the cow down the fence, making at least one turn each way on the fence. The contestant shall then take the cow to an open part of the arena and circle it at least once in each direction.

The cow work portion of the working cow horse class must be completed within two minutes.

Scoring emphasis on the cow work portion shall be based on the horse maintaining control of the cow at all times, exhibiting superior cow sense and natural cow working ability without excessive reining or spurring.

Scoring will be on the basis of 0 to 100, with 70 denoting an average performance. The same basis of scoring shall apply to both the reined work and cow work. In the event of a tie, the entry with the highest cow work will be declared the winner.

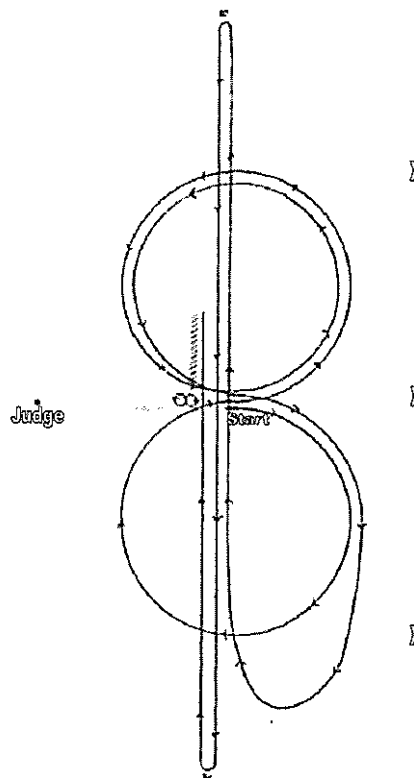
Entrants will be penalised, or may receive a 'Zero' score for a variety of faults.

Please Note:

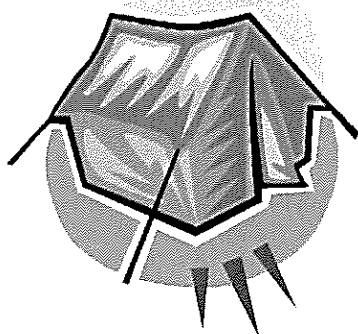
Under normal rules for ALL western performance events, senior horses (aged 6 years and over) MUST be ridden one handed in a bridle (ie curb bit).

For the purposes of the Working Cowhorse stage of this event only however, senior horses (aged 6 years and over) MAY be shown one handed and in a snaffle bit.



Mandatory Marker Along Fence or Wall Ride Pattern as Follows:

1. Beginning at the centre, facing right wall or fence, take a right lead and do a circle to the right, away from the judge, of moderate size and speed.
2. At the centre of the arena, change leads and do two circles to the left both of moderate size and speed.
3. At the centre of the arena, change leads.
4. Go to the end of the arena without stopping or breaking gait, and begin run down near the approximate centre of the arena; run the length of the arena past marker.
5. Do a square, sliding stop, hesitate.
6. Turn left and begin a run to the opposite end of the arena; run length of arena past the marker.
7. Do a square, sliding stop, then hesitate.
8. Turn right, and begin a run down past the centre marker of the arena.
9. Do a sliding stop, and back to the centre of the arena or at least 3 metres (10 feet). Let horse settle in approximate area of stop.
10. Do a 360-degree spin to the right.
11. Do a 360-degree spin to the left.
12. Hesitate to show completion of pattern.
13. Approach judge for inspection and dismissal.

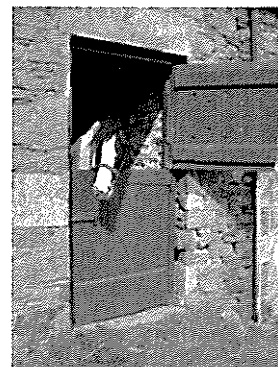


Stabling and Camping

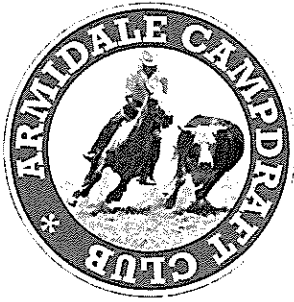

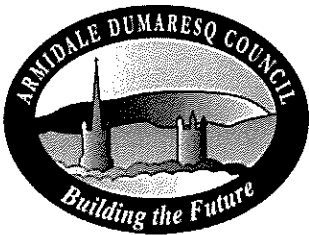
